

Pacific Health Care Organization, Inc. Reports Second Quarter 2018 Results

NEWPORT BEACH, Calif., August 20, 2018 (GLOBE NEWSWIRE) – Pacific Health Care Organization, Inc., (the “Company”) (OTCQB: PFHO) today filed with the Securities and Exchange Commission (the “Commission”) its quarterly report on Form 10-Q announcing its financial results for the periods ended June 30, 2018.

Results

The Company reported net income of \$325,154, or \$0.10 per basic and fully diluted common share for the second quarter ended June 30, 2018, compared to net income of \$240,480, or \$0.08 per basic and fully diluted common share, for the second quarter ended June 30, 2017. For the first six months of 2018, the Company reported net income of \$724,835 or \$0.23 per basic and, fully diluted common share, compared to net income of \$462,737 or \$0.14 per basic and fully diluted common share for the first six months of 2017.

Total revenues for the second quarter 2018 were \$1,661,517 compared to \$1,675,637 for the same period in 2017, a decrease of \$14,120 or 1 percent. For the first six months of 2018 the Company recorded total revenue of \$3,244,826 compared to total revenues of \$3,216,893 for the same period in 2017, an increase of \$27,933 or 1 percent.

Net cash provided by operating activities increased to \$760,254 during the six months ended June 30, 2018, compared to \$438,949 for the same period in 2017, an increase of \$321,305 or 73 percent. Cash balance at June 30, 2018, and December 31, 2017, was \$6,544,384 and \$5,815,071 respectively.
